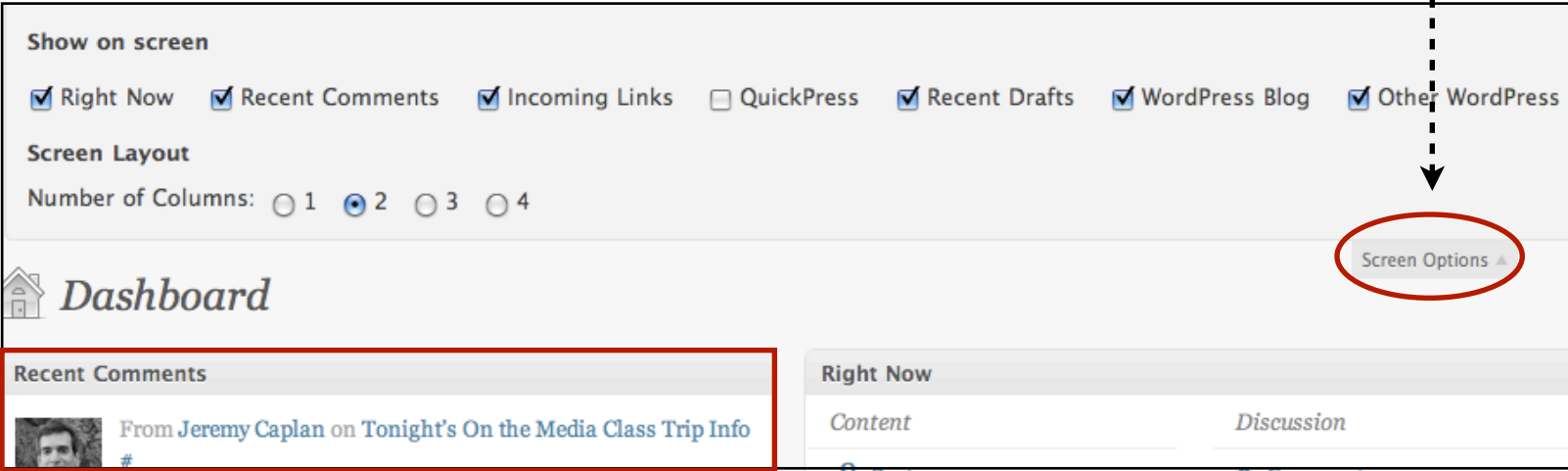


# Dashboard

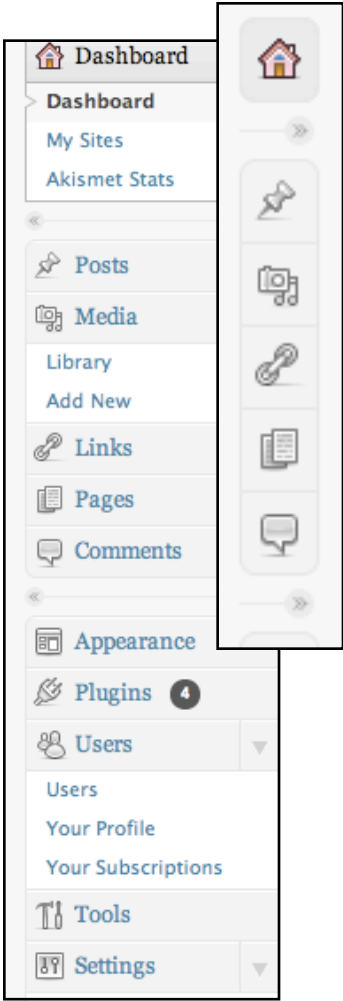
Your dashboard is customizable

Any box with a dark grey bar can be collapsed and expanded with the click of a mouse. Also, you can move the boxes around by clicking and dragging them to the desired destination.

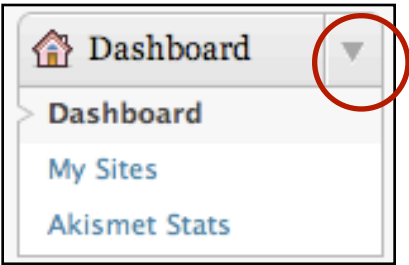
# Sidebar



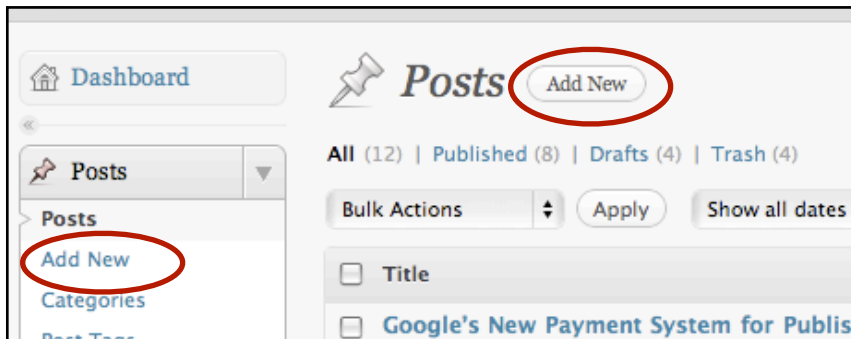
You can collapse and expand your sidebar by clicking on the arrows along the bar.

# Posts

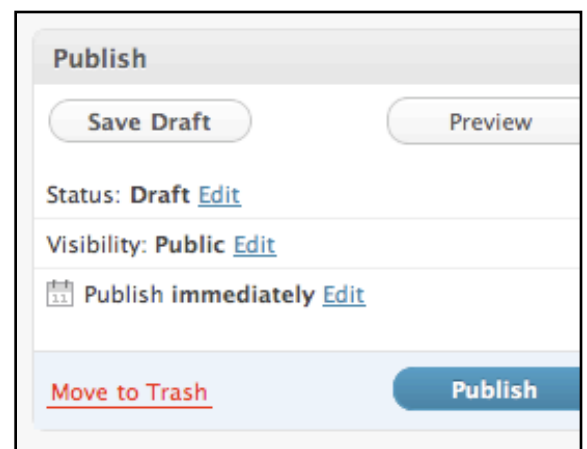


You can add a new post by going to the **Posts** page and clicking the **Add New** button at the top of the page.

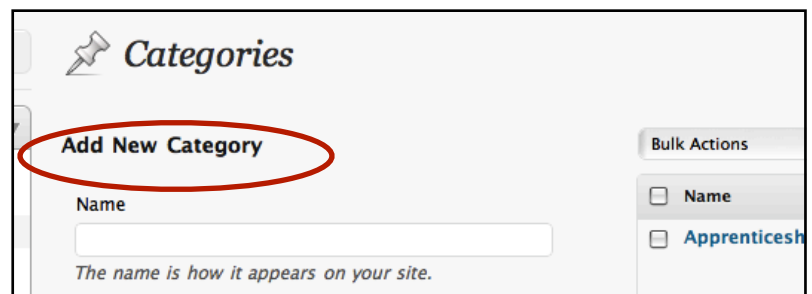
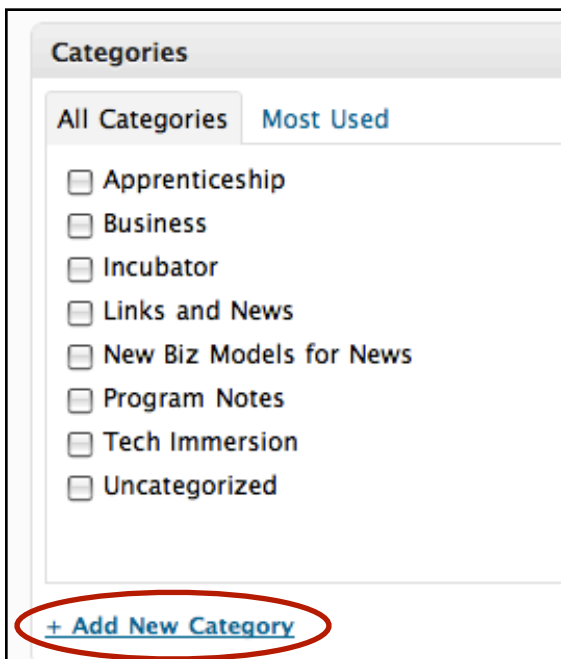
Or by clicking **Add New** in the drop down in your **sidebar**.
